Materials and Resources

MR Credit 4: Recycled Content (1-2 points)

List Industries buys most of their steel direct from the mill. The steel bought is made up of 50.4% post-consumer recycled content and 10.3% post-industrial/pre-consumer.

MR Credit 5: Regional Materials (1-2 points)

Art Metal Products has their manufacturing facility located in Deerfield Beach, FL. However, products are shipped to six Distribution Centers located across the country where they are stored and/or assembled. Those locations are: Carrollton, TX, Munster, IN, Memphis, TN, Battleboro, NC, and Apopka, FL.

MR Credit 7: Certified Wood (1 point)

List Industries have wood lockers available that are FSC (Forest Stewardship Council) Certified.
